The Foreign Languages and Literatures Department accepts a 201 credit-level<sup>1</sup> passing score from BYU's Foreign Language Achievement Testing Services (FLATS) in the languages below to fulfill the Bachelor of Arts foreign language requirement—**this is a non-credit option.**

These tests are by correspondence and are proctored by Testing Services in the Center for Student Health and Counseling (SHAC). It is the student's responsibility to order the test from the FLATS website (<http://flats.byu.edu>) and make the necessary arrangements with the Testing Services office. Tests will be returned to FLATS for grading and results will be sent to both the student and the FLL department. There is a two-and-a-half hour time limit; all tests are pass/fail, multiple-choice and include a listening comprehension section. Please allow three to four weeks for completion of the testing and evaluation process and consider the mandatory 6-month waiting period for re-taking a failed test. The total cost is \$65 (\$40 FLATS, \$25 Testing Services) for taking a test by correspondence.

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<sup>1</sup> All tests cover courses equivalent to 18 quarter hours of pass/fail credit. They are designed to test beginning-level (i.e. first- and second-year) listening comprehension, reading comprehension, and grammatical accuracy.
