An undergraduate foreign language major must complete 32 upper division credits (numbered 300 or higher) in language, literature, & culture, an additional 8 credits in 400-level language & literature courses (excluding 401-410), 8 credits in advisor-approved electives, and 4 credits in linguistics (Ling 390, FL 390, or a linguistics course in the target language). 20 of the 52 credits must be taken in residence at PSU (excludes credit by exam but includes study abroad credit from PSU approved programs). All courses used to satisfy major requirements must be passed with a grade of C or higher.
