

Requirements for the B.A. in Japanese

1. **40 upper-division** (300-level or above) credits in JPN (Native JPN speakers may not take language courses: 301, 302, 304, 411, 412, 417.)

2. **8 additional upper-division** credits in JPN or any course that has ‘Japan’ as its focus (from ARH, GEOG, HST, INTL)

3. **One course in linguistics** (JPN 314, 315, 414, 325, 494, FLL 390, LING 390)

TOTAL: 52 upper-division credits, all with a grade of C or above. C- and P are not acceptable. Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 on all courses used to satisfy the major requirements. Residence at PSU: At least 20 of the 52 credits for this major must be completed at PSU or in overseas programs in which the FLL dept. participates. Credit-by-exam does not count toward the degree.
