REQUIREMENTS FOR THE M.A.T. IN SPANISH EFFECTIVE SUMMER 2008:

Earn 45 graduate credits, grade B or better, including:

- 4 credits FL 560 (must be taken the first term available after admission to the program)
- 4 credits FL 598 (must be taken the first term available after admission to the program)
- At least 8 credits of SPAN 551, 552 or 553 (you should take these courses whenever possible)
- 9-15 credits of 500-level, advisor-approved Education coursework
- 14-20 credits of other 500-level, advisor-approved coursework

Demonstrate reading competence in a second foreign language: Receive a grade of 70% or better in a university foreign language course numbered 203 or higher (excluding 299) other than Spanish or English, *or* pass the GSFLT exam, *or* certify native proficiency in a language other than English or Spanish.

Demonstrate original research: Submit and orally defend two research papers in adviser-approved subject areas—one in language or language pedagogy, the other in literature—written in Spanish or English, 20-25 pages long, not including the list of works cited.

Demonstrate written and spoken comprehensive competence: Pass final written and oral comprehensive examinations. The written exam covers all coursework applied to the degree (on your GO-12 form) *except FL 560 and FL 598*, and the reading list of “Obras maestras selectas.” The oral exam covers all coursework applied to the degree *except FL 560 and FL 598*, all questions on the written exam (answered and unanswered), the “Obras maestras selectas,” and your research papers.

At least 30 of the 45 credits for this M.A.T. must be completed in residence after admission to the program.
